FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT, March 2014

European Workshop on Sea Buckthorn – EuroWorkS has been held two times: in 2010 in Potsdam, Germany and in 2012 in Vilnius, Lithuania. This third conference will be held in Naantali, Finland.

The Conference in Naantali is organized in a workshop format to allow more time for discussion of important subjects. Keynote speakers will introduce general themes and specific problems will be discussed in small groups. During this conference we will focus on three main areas of interest:

Themes of the conference

- ▶ Pests and Diseases of Sea Buckthorn – our main concern is Sea Buckthorn fly
- ▶ Cultivation Technology in Europe – meeting the needs of growers
- ▶ Quality of Sea Buckthorn – can it be standardized?

Participants invited to present a keynote lecture should send their abstracts containing a maximum of 5000 characters (spaces included) by email by June 7th to ekaterina.petruneva@mtt.fi. The abstract template will be emailed to you in April.

Both keynote lectures and posters will be published online at MTT Reports. Please bring your complete publication to the conference on a memory stick or send it by email to ekaterina.petruneva@mtt.fi. The template and instructions for submission will be emailed to participants at the time of the second conference announcement. Lectures and posters submitted after October 16th cannot be published in the Conference Proceedings.

Accommodations and venue

EuroWorkS 2014 is will be held at Herrankukkaro, which provides accomodations, conference venue, and cultural programs at one location. Herrankukkaro is located in the Turku archipelago and there is no public transport available. Shuttlebus transportation will be available for arrival and departure. The entire resort will be reserved for EuroWorkS 2014 participants.
